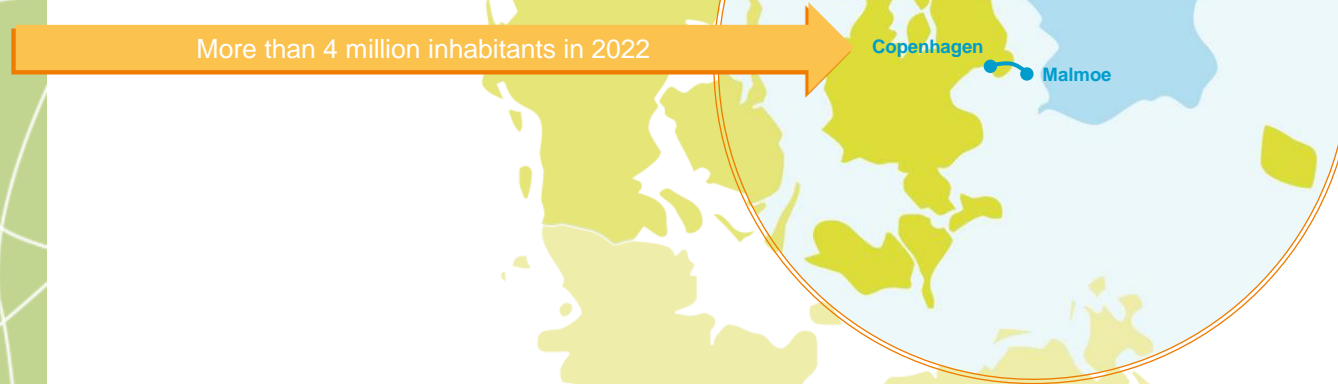

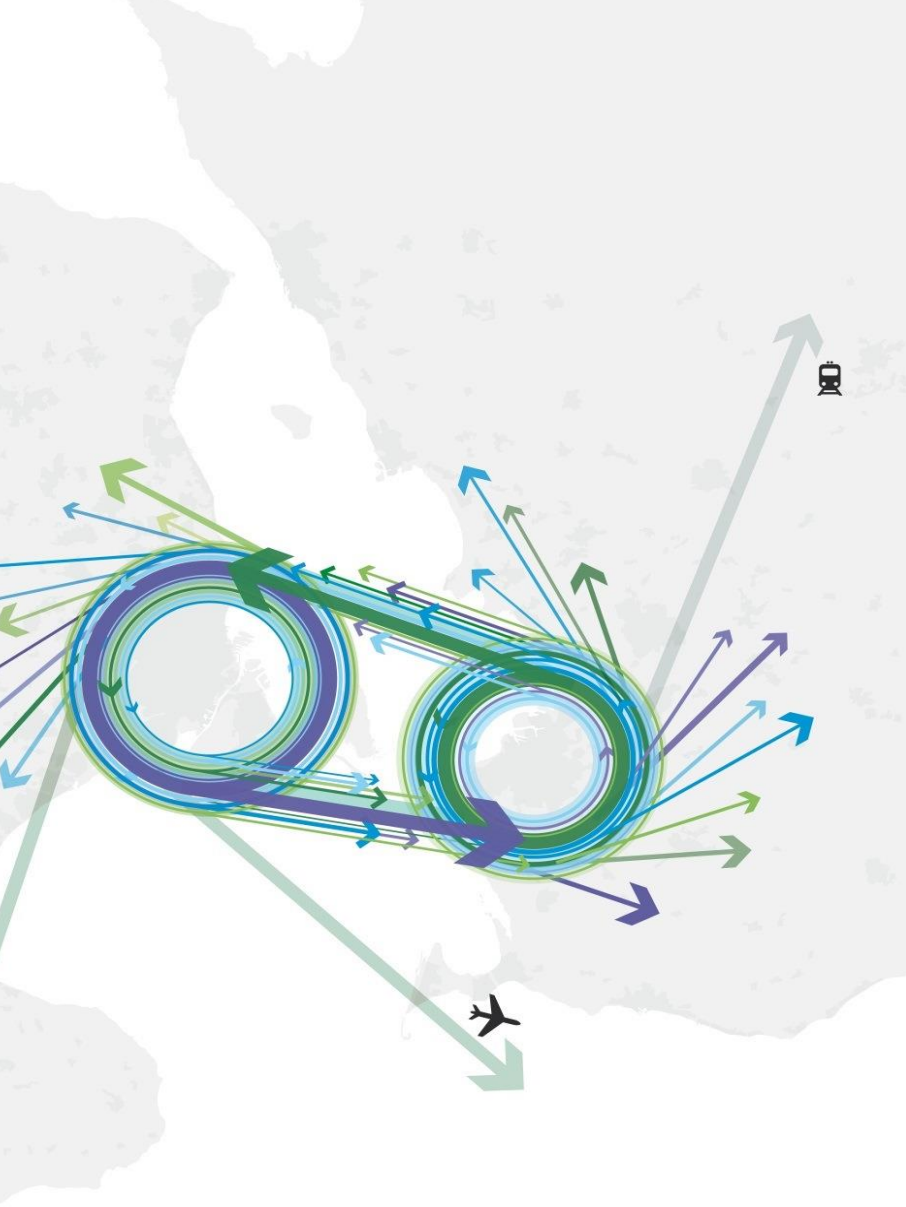

Interreg V - Öresund

- The Territorial Co-operation Programmes, also called Interreg. Financed by the European Regional Development Fund.
- Tillväxtverket (The Swedish Agency for Economic and Regional Growth) has been tasked with coordinating the learning process around Territorial Co-operation Programmes in Sweden.

- The Öresundmetro
- longrun, to build a second commuting route Malmö-Copenhagen. Projects look into impact of the metro when it comes to; , environment, commuting, growth, employment, integration on both sides of the straight.
- ESS and MAX IV: Cross Border Science and Society
- aims to eliminate border restrictions connected to the research facilities.
- Partnership for Growth
- Political initiative: Malmö and Copenhagen as ONE region. Cooperation in three areas; attracting international investors, visible development additions and a strategic frame for the cooperation.
